## Who Stole the Cookie from the Cookie Jar?

Who stole the cookie from the cookie jar? / Who took the cookies from the cookie jar?
(Name of a child in the circle) stole the cookie from the cookie jar / took the cookies from the cookie jar.
Who, me? (Student points to himself)
Yes, you! (Students nod their heads and point at the student)
Not me! /Couldn't be! /Wasn't me! (Student shakes his head "no")
Then who? (Everyone shrugs their shoulders)
This is followed by the "accused" saying the name of someone else, as "(name of a child in the circle) stole the cookie from the cookie jar," and the subsequent back-and-forth lines are repeated.

Who stole the cookie from the cookie jar? / Who took the cookies from the cookie jar?
(Name of a child in the circle) stole the cookie from the cookie jar / took the cookies from the cookie jar. Who, me? (Student points to himself)
Yes, you! (Students nod their heads and point at the student)
Okay, okay... I took the cookie!
I stole the cookie from the cookie jar.
The yummy, yummy cookie from the cookie jar.
Are you hungry?
